

# CLOSURE PLANNING CONCEPTS

- Existing 2006 Mine Closure Plan to be updated in 2010 (complete)
- Remove mine hazards within the Hollinger site footprint through:
  - Mining out and/or backfilling near surface historic pits and stopes
  - Backfilling and flooding the proposed new open pit workings
  - Retaining fencing around any remaining unsafe areas
  - Removal of existing buildings and planned /existing infrastructure
  - Progressive rehabilitation of mine rock stockpiles
  - General site restoration at closure to a park like recreational setting together with integrated natural areas and a pit lake, all suitable for safe local recreation use
- Site Plan Control Agreement with the City of Timmins to enhance the aesthetics during operation and at closure
